

BYLAW 2021-10

BEING A BYLAW OF WHEATLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE ROCKY VIEW COUNTY AND WHEATLAND COUNTY INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 230, 606, 631 AND 692 OF THE *MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT*, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS Section 631 of the *Municipal Government Act* states that two or more Councils of municipalities that have common boundaries may, by each passing a Bylaw, adopt an intermunicipal development plan;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Wheatland County wishes to adopt an intermunicipal development plan in consultation with Rocky View County;

AND WHEREAS the municipality must prepare a corresponding bylaw and provide for its consideration at a public hearing;

AND WHEREAS a Public Hearing was held on May 18, 2021 at the Wheatland County office and via conference call in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, Section 199;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, the Council of Wheatland County enacts as follows:

1. Council shall adopt the Rocky View County and Wheatland County Intermunicipal Development Plan, attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
2. This Bylaw comes into force when it receives third reading and is signed by the Reeve/Deputy Reeve and the CAO or Designate as per the *Municipal Government Act*;
3. The Rocky View County and Wheatland County Intermunicipal Development Plan comes into force when Wheatland County and Rocky View County give third readings to their respective bylaws.
